## Aller - To go

<b>Je vais</b>	I go/I am going
<b>Tu vas</b>	you go/you are going
<b>Il va/ Elle va</b>	He goes/he is going/she goes/she is going
<b>Nous allons</b>	we go/we are going
<b>Vous allez</b>	you go/you are going
<b>Ils vont/elles vont</b>	They go/they are going (masc/fem)

Use **aller** - to go, in the **present tense**, + an infinitive verb.

The near future tense = I am going + infinitive



Preposition use with countries depends on the gender

<b>Je vais</b>	<b>I'm going</b>	
<b>au Canada (m)</b>	<b>en France (f)</b>	<b>aux États-Unis (pl)</b>
<b>to Canada</b>	<b>to France</b>	<b>to the United States</b>
