Our St Edward's logo.



'Operemur Bonum' is latin for 'let us do good'.

The sheild is a coat of arms representing St. Edward the Confessor (although it was never actually used by him as people did not use coats of arms when he was alive).

It was created several centuries later, probably using a design from the reverse of one of Edward the Confessors coins which had a cross with birds (called Martlets) in each quadrant. 'Martlet' is an old word for a bird like a swift.
